### **Hi Beanstalks!**

If you want to print out the Bean Pod\* to look like a book:

- 1. Print out the pages (you might check the "reverse order" box when you print so the end product is a pile of spreads in the right order, with the cover on top, and the Calendar page right under it. Otherwise you'll have to put the pages in order yourself.
- 2. Then take the cover page, place it face down on the table and put the stack (with the Calendar page being on top) on top of the faced-down cover page.
- 3. Staple in the corner, and fold in half like a booklet, and you'll have the closest thing you can get to a booklet without using a saddle stitcher!
- \*If you want to save your color ink, you can print it in black and white.

Follow Edgell Rd for 2.3 miles until you come to a light, where there is a Plaza on the right & an Exxon gast station on left. Take a RIGHT at the light onto WATER ST. \*\*Follow Water St for 1/2 mile to SPRING LANE. Spring Ln is on your RIGHT, almost immediately after Chesterfield (there's a house with a wooden fence on the corner). The street is set back a little, so PAY ATTENTION! If you miss it, take a RIGHT onto PAMELA RD, & the Halbergs' house is at the top of of Pamela Rd.
- **4. FROM THE NORTH (& OTHERS):** Take RT 2 to RT 27 South. Follow RT 27 South to Sudbury Center. Take RIGHT onto CONCORD RD. At the fork, bear RIGHT onto UNION AVE. Follow Union Ave. to light, & take RIGHT onto RT 20. Get into left lane, & take LEFT at light onto NOBSCOTT RD. \*\*\*Nobscott Rd turns into Edgell Rd at the Framingham town line. Follow this road about 2-3 miles. At the first light, take LEFT onto WATER ST. Follow the 3., directions above, from "\*\*Follow Water St for 1/2 mile..."

From RT 128/Interstate 95 North: Take 95 South to exit for RT 20. At end of exit, bear RIGHT, following Rt 20 towards Weston/Sudbury, etc. Follow Rt 20 for a while into Sudbury. When you see Sudbury Farms market on your left, and you go straight through the light at intersection of Union Ave., get in the left lane take a LEFT onto NOBSCOTT RD. & follow directions from above, from "\*\*\*Nobscott Rd turns into Edgell Rd..."
